The undersigned, Commissioner of Highways of the Township of Brooklyn in said County, would respectfully represent that culverts on Shady Oaks and Carnahan Roads in said township, for which the Township of Brooklyn is wholly responsible; that the total cost of said work will be \$28,882.87 dollars, in which \$28,882.87 (100%) of the total shall be paid for with local funds in which that sum will be more than two cents on the one hundred dollars on the latest assessment roll, and the levy of the Road and Bridge Tax or the Township Joint Bridge Tax for two years last past in said township was in each year not less than the sum of sixteen and one-half cents or five cents respectively on which is needed for the ordinary repairs of the roads and bridges.
