

ABSENTEE VOTING UNDERWAY

Absentee voting for the April 7, 2009 Consolidated Election is now being conducted by Lee County Clerk and Recorder Nancy Nelson's Office.

Persons may apply for absentee ballots by mail or in person at the Lee County Clerk's election office on the first floor of the Old Lee County Courthouse. Ballots for in-office absentee voting are available. To vote by absentee ballot in Illinois, a person must be a registered voter and unable to vote in person at the polls on election day because he or she expects to be absent from the county on election day, is physically incapable of going to the polling place, observing a religious holiday, serving as a sequestered juror or is an election judge outside his or her precinct.
