**WALNUT FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT  
INCREASE MAXIMUM ALLOWABLE RATE**

Shall the maximum allowable tax rate for the Walnut Fire Protection District be increased from 0.125% to 0.40% of the value of all taxable property within the District as equalized or assessed by the Department of Revenue?	Yes

**WALNUT FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT  
SPECIAL TAX FOR PROVIDING AMBULANCE SERVICE**

Shall the Walnut Fire Protection District levy a special tax at a rate not to exceed .30% of the value of all taxable property within the district as equalized or assessed by the Department of Revenue for the purpose of providing an ambulance service?	Yes

**BROOKLYN TOWNSHIP ROAD DISTRICT  
INCREASE PROPERTY TAX EXTENSION LIMITATION**

Shall the extension limitation under the Property Tax Extension Limitation Law for the Brooklyn Township Road District, Lee County, Illinois, be increased from the lesser of 5% or the percentage increase in the Consumer Price Index over the prior levy year to 25% per year for each of the levy years 2009, 2010, 2011 and 2012? **Supplemental Information**

(1) For the levy year 2009 the approximate amount of the additional tax extendable against property containing a single family residence and having a fair market value at the time of the referendum of \$100,000 is estimated to be \$39.32.

(2) Based upon an average annual percentage increase in the market value of such property of 4.68%, the approximate amount of the additional tax extendable against such property for the 2010 levy year is estimated to be \$60.66, for the levy year 2011 is estimated to be \$79.37 and for the levy year 2012 is estimated to be \$103.86.

**HARMON TOWNSHIP ROAD DISTRICT  
INCREASE PROPERTY TAX EXTENSION LIMITATION**

Shall the extension limitation under the Property Tax Extension Limitation Law for the Harmon Township Road District, Lee County, Illinois, be increased from the lesser of 5% or the percentage increase in the Consumer Price Index over the prior levy year to 109% per year for the levy year 2009?	Yes

**Supplemental Information**

For the levy year 2009 the approximate amount of the additional tax extendable against property containing a single family residence and having a fair market value at the time of the referendum of \$100,000 is estimated to be \$112.67.
